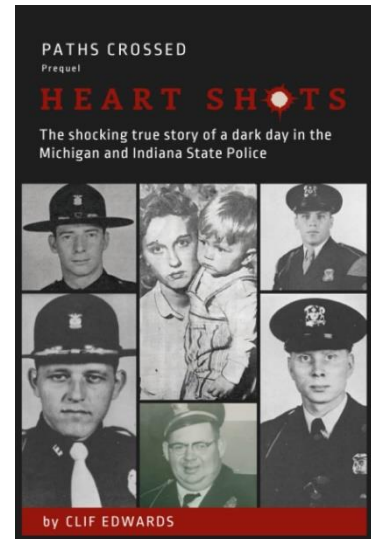

Ten hours, nine heroes, five heart shots, three abductions, two widows, and one fatherless son would lead Clif Edwards to investigate and write this story the courage of eight officers standing in harm's way; two of which would die. This is their story and the story of Michigan Trooper Dugald Pellot and Indiana Trooper William Kellems who met up with those that took their life on September 30, 1957.



Clif Edwards was only 2 years old when this tragedy occurred. He later went into law enforcement at the Michigan State Police serving in Jackson and Lenawee Counties.

The book honors the following officers from Michigan and Indiana: Michigan State Police Trooper Douglas Vogel and Dugald Pellot and Sergeant Frederick O'Donnell; Indiana State Police Trooper William Kellems and Robert Pond; Jennings County Sheriff Charles Dudley and Deputy Sheriff Clyde Perkins; and North Vernon Indiana Police Patrolman Lester Kenens.
