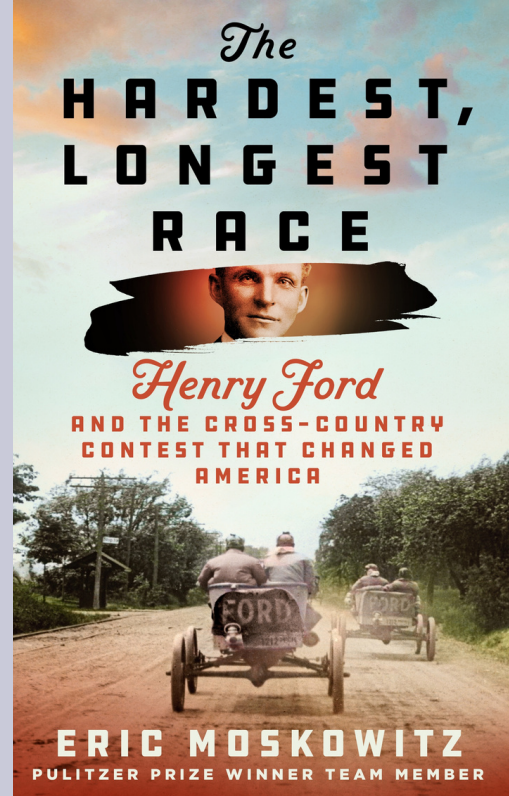




Virtual Talk with author Eric Moskowitz



A Gripping Account of a Coast-to-Coast Car Race in 1909

Three of the 253 automakers in the US in 1909 showed up to participate in a car race from New York to the World's Fair in Seattle.

The Model T wasn't favored to win. But Henry Ford was intent on proving that the Model T could go the distance and beat out the muscular luxury cars.

Indeed, a little over three weeks after the race began, a Model T crossed the finish line hours ahead of the other cars.

But the Victory was a fraud.
