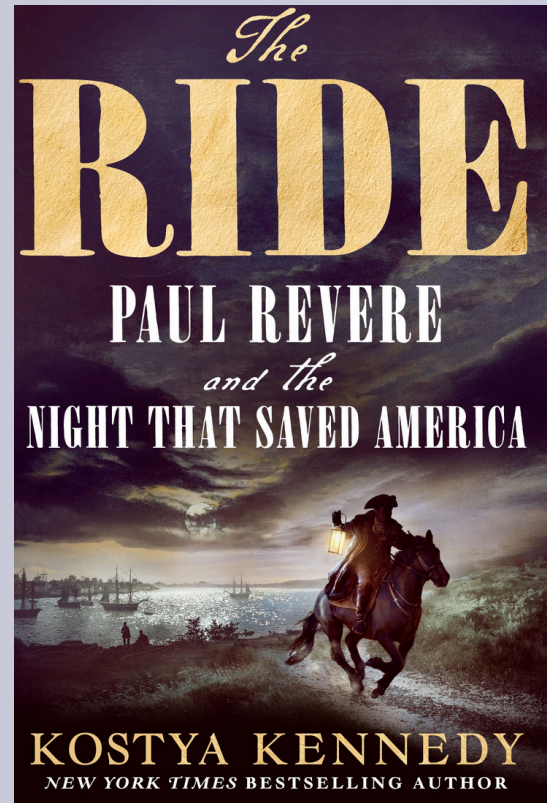




Virtual Talk with author Kostya Kennedy
