- Provide prompt, courteous, and direct assistance to patrons in a library setting
- Assist library patrons with information needs, in both print and digital formats
- Develop and implement programs and services to fulfill the diverse recreational, enrichment, and educational needs for youth ages birth through 18 years of age
- Actively engage children in the community by providing outreach services to local schools, community centers, and community agencies
- Assists in preparing exhibits and seasonal displays throughout the children's area
- Provide technical assistance in computer area
- Place holds on library materials
- Place interlibrary loan requests
- Circulate materials
- Accurately shelve materials
- Manage information desk, phone, and email inquiries
- Advocate for youth within the library organization and in the community
- Ensure safety and code of conduct are followed by patrons
- Refers information requests requiring professional assistance to librarians
- Attend continuing education courses and trainings
