During the chat with Angeline, she will share about her debut novel, the influence behind it, her Native American culture, and more.

Angeline is a member of the Sault Ste. Marie Tribe of Chippewa Indians. Her next book, *Warrior Girl Unearthed* is set for release in May 2023.
