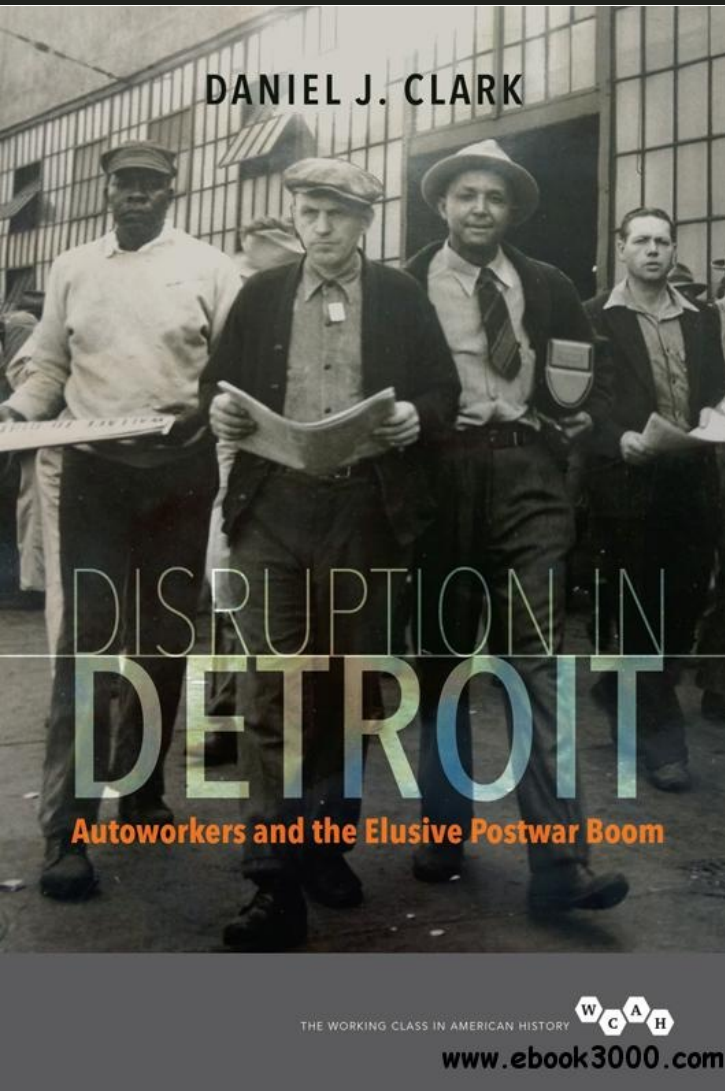


DISRUPTION IN DETROIT
