Who is *Highly Trivial*? Caleb Driker-Ohren is an educator, trivia nut, and young professional based in Washington, DC. He began composing and hosting trivia events for family and friends after COVID prevented them from convening in person. Since then he has morphed his hobby into an enterprise, working with campaigns, non-profits, and groups of friends to provide joy, humor, and fundraising remotely through trivia.

How does trivia night work? *Highly Trivial* works with our clients to create custom rounds and clues. Each team receives a blank answer sheet over email before the event. The host then facilitates the rounds over Zoom as teams fill in their sheets, kibitz, and compete.

Who can participate in trivia night? Trivia night is for everyone. Because we create each event from scratch, *Highly Trivial* engages the most ardent trivia buffs and novices alike, and can be adjusted to meet the needs of any group. We can also create children-centered events for kids ages 8 and older.

How many participants can you accommodate?

A maximum of 20 teams. The number of players per team does not matter, as long as Zoom can accommodate the total number of screens.

How long does trivia night last? Depending on the number of rounds, trivia night can last anywhere from 1 to 3 hours.

How much does an event cost? With a base cost of \$250, the parameters of the event ultimately determine the price, which never exceeds \$500.

When is *Highly Trivial* available to host events?

Weekdays after 4:00 PM and weekends anytime. With prior notice of at least a month, some weekday events before 4:00 PM can be accommodated.

How much advance notice is needed to put on an event? We ask for a month's advance notice from first contact until the actual event date. Two weeks is the minimum amount of time needed to create the event.
